Namibia

Namibia is a country of open spaces and great contrasts. It is set between 2 deserts, the Namib in the west and the Kalahari in the east. The country only gained its independence in 1990, but one can still clearly see a German and European influence as well as the African traditions. The Namib desert is home to miles of beautiful red and yellow sand dunes, vast plains, rugged canyons of volcanic rock and distant mountain ranges. Common game includes Giraffe, Oryx, Mountain Zebra, and Ostrich.

Little Kulala, the flagship of Namibia's extraordinary Sossusvlei area, has been enthralling informed travellers, who are attracted by the first-class facilities, charming hospitality and nearby proximity to the towering sand dunes. This acclaimed Wilderness Safaris desert retreat, in the only reserve with direct access to Sossusvlei, has climate-controlled villas and an elegant entertainment area that includes al fresco fine dining as a highlight. The 11 elegant canvas-and-thatch villas merge impeccably into the timeless desert landscape, with exquisite fittings and fixtures, innovative bleached decks each with a private plunge pool.

Little Ongava, in the private 66 000 acre Ongava game reserve shares a common boundary with Etosha National Park, nestles on the crest of a hill with wonderful views onto the plains below. Enjoy unrivalled privacy with only three spacious suites, each with private plunge pool, en-suite bathroom, a sala, and outdoor shower with views of the waterhole in front of camp. Little Ongava's entertainment area lends itself to relaxed, stylish dining.
